



- All staff undergo appropriate background and safeguarding checks, and provide references
- All staff are safeguarding trained to level 1, management staff to level 2 and the designated safeguarding officer is trained to level 3
- First-aid trained staff on campus. Students will be taken to local A&E in cases of emergency or injury
- Management staff are available to help and support 24 hours a day
- Management assist with accommodation issues, campus orientation, and advise on local religious or cultural organisations
- A comprehensive safeguarding policy is regularly updated and is covered at staff induction days

Students' Safety

- An Emergency Action Plan is in place to protect and care for our students
- Upon arrival, students are issued with lanyards and ID cards with an emergency contact number on it
- 24-hour CCTV on every campus as well as 24/7 security teams on university campuses
- Students are given an induction talk upon arrival, detailing safety regulations & rules
- Individual students are allocated a member of staff who will act as their group leader at all times
- Student Handbooks, which contain important information and emergency contacts, are accessible by QR code on on each student's ID card
- There is a 24-hour emergency contact number for partner agencies, parents and students
- We assist group leaders to ensure students' safety and care outside of scheduled activities and during excursions

Support & Care

- Students are supervised during activities, classes and excursions, as well as break and meal times
- We provide help with airport transfers
- We provide balanced menus with vegetarian and healthy options. Dietary requirements are catered for
- We have robust assessments for activities, excursions and venues. These are regularly reviewed and updated
- All group leaders are given an induction talk when they arrive which details their responsibilities towards their group but also as an adult at a residential centre

Academic Programme
