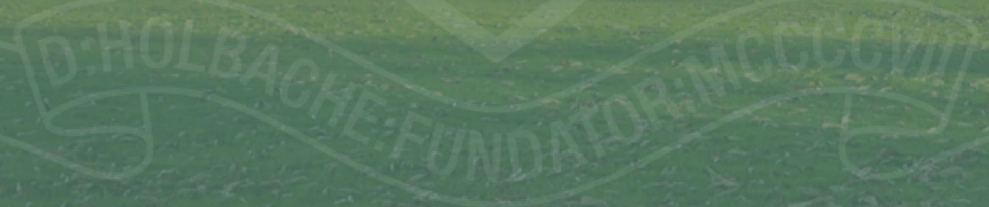

## ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

Pupils needing support with English language will have two English lessons each day with our qualified teachers and then two lessons based on our weekly curricular theme.

Pupils with fluent English will join our advanced track which includes support for University and Career application.

## AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES

Each day, pupils will have the opportunity to select from a vast list of activities. They can select from creative, social, academic and sporting options - and we do insist that at least one choice must be active!

While there are three slots available each afternoon, some activities, such as country walking or horse-riding may take up two or even three of those slots.

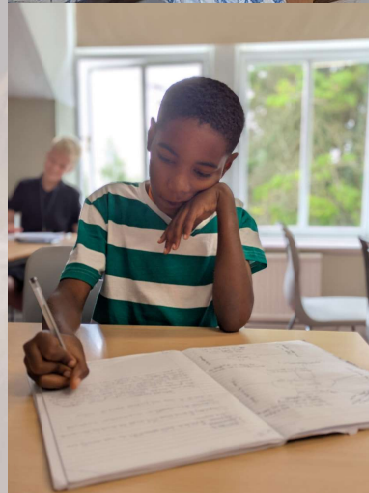
# ENGLISH LANGUAGE

Our qualified teachers deliver well-designed and carefully tailored English language lessons to suit all abilities.

With small class sizes (we aim at a maximum of fourteen pupils) and with teaching assistants on hand to support, our programme helps pupils challenge themselves and make strong progress in a warm and nurturing environment.

Prior to joining the course, all students have an informal on-line meeting with the course director. This helps us to assess their English level and find out a little about them.

# ADVANCED TRACK

Many of our pupils have excellent English skills and do not require lessons in the language.

Where this is the case, our Junior students will have additional lessons in our enhanced curriculum which covers Science, Economics, Art, Culture, Literature, Government and Leadership.

For Senior students we also offer a Careers and University Preparation Course, which supports them with writing a Personal Statement (SOP), preparing for interview and also analysing the skills and personal qualities needed for elite universities and courses in Law, Medicine, Engineering, Business and Computer Science.



# LEAD

An outstanding co-curricular offering ensures that there are choices to suit all talents, interests and abilities.

From basketball to beekeeping pupils can do what they enjoy, show off their skills and discover something new every day of the week.

All this is offered alongside a range of excursions to places of local, national and international interest including Shakespeare's Birthplace and Oxford University.



# LIVE

Set in extraordinarily beautiful grounds and equipped with nationally recognised boarding facilities, we ensure that Oswestry really does become home for pupils while they are with us.

Our expert, round-the-clock care from a dedicated pastoral team not only creates a safe environment, but helps us to get to know each pupil personally, to understand their hopes for the programme and to celebrate their achievements in all areas.



# ACCOMODATION

All pupils are accomodated on site in our three, beautiful boarding houses.

Many of our rooms are en-suite and the vast majority are built for two to share, although there are some larger dormitories, which are often sought-after, particularly by younger pupils!

Each boarding house will have a resident House Parent and Assistant.

Group leaders are also accomodated in a separate building on the school site.

All food is provided on site by our outstanding, award-winning catering team.

They will not only provide for all allergies, intolerances and other dietary requirements, but will also work hard to blend classic UK cuisine with home tastes for a wide range of our visiting pupils.

There is always a choice of hot option at every meal as well as a salad bar and dessert.

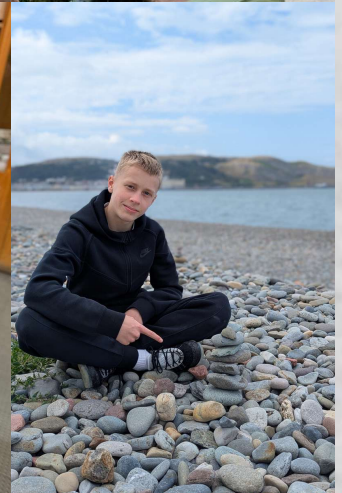

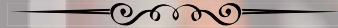
